 - ◇ Accredited by the Navajo Department of Health
- Less than two hour class covering Food Safety Practices, including:
- ⇒ Cross Contamination
 - ⇒ Time and Temperature
 - ⇒ Personal Hygiene & Handwashing

- ⇒ **NO PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED**
- ⇒ **DO NOT BRING YOUNG CHILDREN TO THE TRAINING**
- ⇒ Bring a pen/pencil and a notepad
- ⇒ The training will be taught in English—bring a Navajo interpreter, if needed
- ⇒ To earn a Food Service Training Certificate (blue) card, all participants must attend the training and pass the test
- ⇒ NOEH is now accepting debit/credit cards and money order payments for the Itinerant Food Permit (pink) card

 - \$5 for six-months or \$10 for one-year
