- ⇒ A two hour class covering food safety practices, personal hygiene, etc.
- ⇒ Accredited by the Navajo Department of Health

- ⇒ **NO PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED**
- ⇒ **ARRIVE ON TIME**
- ⇒ **BRING A PEN/PENCIL AND A NOTE PAD**
- ⇒ **DO NOT BRING YOUNG CHILDREN TO THE TRAINING**
- ⇒ 12 years and older can participate and take the test
- ⇒ Two-hour training session
- ⇒ To earn a Food Service Training Certificate (blue) card, after attending the training and pass a 25-question test
- ⇒ NOEH is now accepting debit/credit cards and money order payments for the Itinerant Food Permit (pink) card
 - Pay to **NAVAJO NATION**
 - \$5 for six-months or \$10 for one-year
